Hedges- Hedge replacement, the replacement planting of new growth to replace the lost due to the hurricane, is being addressed. The board notes that ficus plants are no longer available for sale. The board is researching available options.

Building 24 Parking- Two members have communicated concerns over assigned parking. A document was presented before the Board from twenty (20) years ago stating a previous board's approval of an agreement between a current owner with a documented disability and a now previous owner to swap their parking spaces. A new owner now wishes to reclaim her assigned parking space, as the docs allow. The Board is researching and is mindful of, and has advised both parties that, ADA intervention does supersede our governing docs.

OLD BUSINESS

Hurricane Damage - A deposition is scheduled for March 22. Charlotte, Larry and Todd will attend.

Maintenance Update- The new replacement heat pump for the swimming pool was installed. The four pole lights on the west side of the pool deck are being addressed by Brite Electric. The single pole light at 2916 stairwell has been successfully repaired.

On March 4th three local and state agencies offered presentations relevant to concerns regarding coyotes and coyote activity, control and safety.
